

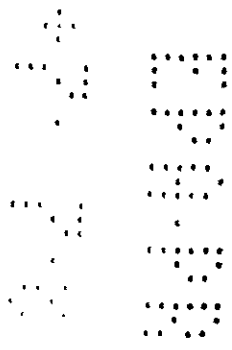

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT

HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Wash thoroughly after using and before eating or smoking. Do not use on household pets or humans. Remove fish and birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

- If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.
- If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
- If on skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
- If in eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
- Note To Physician: If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Avoid storage at high temperatures. Protect from moisture. Avoid contamination with water, acids or alkalis. Do not store near heat or open flame. Keep container closed. Store in original containers only. Separate pesticides to avoid cross contamination of other pesticides. Do not store near food and feed. Keep on a cool, dry, well-ventilated surface.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

"Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash."

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, incinerate, or as allowed by State and local authorities. If burned, stay out of smoke.

Do not mix with dry materials such as sand or sawdust. Do not use for disposal.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act to use a pesticide in a manner not consistent with its labeling.

ROACHES, ANTS, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, CRICKETS, EARWIGS: Spray heavily into all cracks, around baseboards and other places where these insects hide. Also spray until wet, surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves. Spray other localized areas infested with these pests. Repeat treatment as required.

CARPET BEETLES: Make localized application to areas of the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks and under carpets where insects may be found. Treat crevices, cracks or closets and infested areas of shelving. Repeat as necessary.

BROWN DOG TICKS: Thoroughly spray infested areas around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, sleeping quarters of household pets and localized areas of floors and floor coverings. Applications should be repeated as infestations warrant and as re-infestations occur. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. **DO NOT** treat animals with this formulation.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, WASPS AND FLYING MOTHS OUTDOORS: For outdoor use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces or screens, doors, window frames or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages, and other places where these insects alight or congregate.

FLEAS, CHIGGERS, ANTS AND BROWN DOG TICKS OUTDOORS: For treatment of localized infestations of these insects in outdoor areas where there is no vegetation, spray infested areas thoroughly. For ants, thoroughly wet hills and runways. Repeat applications as infestations warrant and as re-infestations occur.
