DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Pool Algae 80 effectively controls the growth of algae in swimming pools. The effectiveness of this product is not influenced by the normal range of swimming pool water pH. There is no waiting to swim in pools treated with this product. Pool Algae 80 is compatible with all pool additives, is non-foaming, will not stain, and is non-corrosive to pool filters, heaters, piping, and fittings. Pool filtering systems will not reduce the effectiveness of this product. The use of this product will not replace the need for chlorine to maintain proper pH and sanitation, but does relieve the need for excessive quantities of chlorine to combat algae.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS:

Mix the correct dosage in a container of clear water, shake or agitate thoroughly, and evenly distribute the mixture over the water to be treated.

CALCULATION OF WATER VOLUME:

To determine the gallons of water in a body of water with a rectangular or square surface, multiply, in feet, the length x width x average depth x 7.5. If the surface of the body of water is oval or round, multiply, in feet, the length x width x average depth x 5.9.

SWIMMING POOLS:

Pool Algae 80 may be poured into the skimmer or evenly distributed around the edge of the pool. Water temperature of 80 F or greater results in faster algae control. Do not allow treated water from pool to contact plants, trees, and shrubs.

GREEN ALGAE CONTROL:

Apply 1 3/4 oz. of Pool Algae 80 (1.06 ppm simazine) per 10,000 gals. of water when algae growth is first visible. Seven days later, brush algae from walls, vacuum out settled algae.

BLACK ALGAE CONTROL:

Apply 2 2/3 oz. of Pool Algae 80 (1.6 ppm simazine) per 10,000 gals. of water when algae growth is first visible. For faster results, remove top of algae growth with wire brush daily and vacuum out settled algae. ✓

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.
