- * Apply undiluted to infested areas until entirely wet. DO NOT USE ON EYELASHES OR EYEBROWS.
- * Allow treatment to remain 10 minutes, but no longer
- * Then wash thoroughly with warm water and shampoo or soap.
- * Dead lice and eggs may require removal with a fine comb.
- * A second treatment must be made in 7 to 10 days to kill any newly hatched lice.

TO PREVENT REINFESTATION:

To avoid reinfestation with head, pubic or body lice, all clothing and bed linen should be disinfected by washing in hot water and drying, using the hot cycle for at least 20 minutes, or by dry-cleaning. Combs and brushes should be soaked in water above 135 F for 5 to 10 minutes. Sexual partners should be treated simultaneously. Rooms inhabited by infested patients should be thoroughly vacuumed.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Head Lice, live on the scalp, laying small white eggs (nits) on the hair shaft close to the scalp. The nits are most easily found on the nape of the neck or behind the ears. All personal headgear, scarves, coats, and bed linen should be disinfected by machine washing in hot water and drying, using the hot cycle of a dryer for at least 20 minutes. Personal articles of clothing or bedding that cannot be washed may be dry-cleaned or sealed in a plastic bag for a period of about 2 weeks. Personal combs and brushes may be disinfected by soaking in hot water (above 130 F) for 5 to 10 minutes. Thorough vacuuming of rooms inhabited by infested patients is recommended.

Crab or pubic lice, generally transmitted by sexual contacts, are very small and look almost like brown or grey dots on the skin. Crab lice usually cause intense itching and lay small white eggs (nits) on the hair shaft close to the skin surface. In hairy individuals, the crab louse may be present on the short hairs of the thighs and trunk, underarms, and occasionally on the beard and mustache. Sexual partners should be treated simultaneously to avoid reinfestation. All underwear should be disinfected by machine washing in hot water; then drying, using the hot cycle for at least 20 minutes.

Body lice, and their eggs are generally found, in the seams of clothing, particularly in the waistline and armpit area. They move to the skin to feed, then return to the seams of the othing, where they lay their eggs. All clothing should be aisinfected by the same procedure outlined for head lice, clothing should be sealed for at least 30 days in a plastic bag for body lice because the nits (eggs) can remain dormant for a period of up to 30 days.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Do not transport or store below 32 F. Do not reuse container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
