**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. THIS PRODUCT IS FOR EXTERNAL USE ON HUMANS ONLY. Apply undiluted to the infested area until entirely wet. DO NOT USE ON EYELASHES OR EYEBROWS.

Allow treatment to remain 10 minutes, but no longer. Then wash thoroughly with warm water and shampoo or soap. Dead lice and eggs may require removal with a fine comb. A second treatment must be made in 7 to 10 days to kill any newly hatched lice.

**TO PREVENT REINFESTATION:** To avoid reinfestation with head, pubic or body lice, all clothing and bed linen should be disinfected by washing in hot water and drying, using the hot cycle for at least 20 minutes, or by dry-cleaning. Combs and brushes should be soaked in water above 135°F for 5 to 10 minutes.

Sexual partners should be treated simultaneously. Rooms inhabited by infested patients should be thoroughly vacuumed.

**GENERAL INFORMATION:** Head Lice live on the scalp, laying small white eggs (nits) on the hair shaft close to the scalp. The nits are most easily found on the nape of the neck or behind the ears. All personal headgear, scarves, coats, and bedlinen should be disinfected by machine washing in hot water and drying, using the hot cycle of a dryer for at least 20 minutes. Personal articles of clothing or bedding that cannot be washed may be dry-cleaned or sealed in a plastic bag for a period of about 2 weeks, or sprayed with a product specially designed for this purpose. Personal combs and brushes may be disinfected by soaking in hot water above 135°F for 5 to 10 minutes. Thorough vacuuming of rooms inhabited by infested patients is recommended.

Pubic (Crab) Lice, generally transmitted by sexual contacts, are very small and look almost like brown or grey dots on the skin. Crab lice usually cause intense itching and lay small white eggs (nits) on the hair shaft close to the skin surface. In hairy individuals, the crab louse may be present on the short hairs of the thighs and trunk, underarms, and occasionally on the beard

and mustache. Sexual partners should be treated simultaneously. All underwear should be washed in hot water and dried on a hot cycle for at least 20 minutes. Body Lice and their eggs are found in the seams of clothing, in the waistline and armpits. Remove clothing from skin to feed, then wash clothing, where the lice are found. Clothing should be disinfected by procedure outlined above. Clothing should be sealed in a plastic bag for body lice. Lice and eggs can remain viable for up to 30 days.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:**  
**CAUTION:** Causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes and avoid contact with mucous membranes. Harmful if swallowed. Causes skin irritation or allergic reaction. If develops, discontinue use and consult a doctor. Consult a doctor if irritation of eyebrows and eyelashes develops.  
**IMPORTANT:** Not to be used on ragweed.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICES:**  
**IF SWALLOWED -** Call Poison Control Center immediately. Drink glasses of water and induce vomiting by drinking the back of the hand. Do not give anything by mouth until vomit is clear.  
**IF INHALED -** Remove person to fresh air.  
**IF IN EYES -** Flush eyes with water. Call a physician if irritation persists.  
**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Do not store in food, or feed by stock. Do not reuse container. Wash thoroughly with soap and water. Do not transfer to trash. Do not transfer to other container. Buyer assumes all responsibility for handling if this material is used in accordance with directions.
