Russell Weed Killer #3

Your Submission Dated August 12, 1985

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA is acceptable provided you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
  - a. Add the subheading Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals preceding the precautionary statements beginning "Harmful if swallowed . . ." and move the subheading Statement of Practical Treatment, to precede the statements beginning "In case of contact . . . ."
  - b. Under Environmental Hazards, change "Weed Killer #1 . . ." to "Weed Killer #3 . . . ."
  - c. In the directions for use, delete the phrase ". . . with Endrift . . ." wherever it appears since your revised formulation will not contain this drift control agent.
2. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of labeling is enclosed for your records.
