**GENERAL INFORMATION:** HI-YIELD DIAZINON INSECT SPRAY contains DIAZINON insecticide, which provides positive control of many hard-to-kill sucking and chewing insects as listed below. HI-YIELD DIAZINON INSECT SPRAY works fast, also remains effective for an extended period of time. **DO NOT USE IN HOME.**

**DIRECTIONS:** For lawns measure area to be sprayed. For all other applications, apply as a thorough cover spray. Make applications when insects first appear. Repeat applications as needed or as noted in Rate Chart. Use coarse drenching spray for lawns, soil and surface applications. Thorough coverage is important. **USE CONTENTS WITHIN 6 MONTHS OF OPENING.** Keep tightly closed. Use clean sprayer. Flush sprayer after each use.

**(NOTE: Do not use on certain ferns, poinsettia, hibiscus, papaya, pilea, gardenia and orchids, since injury may occur.)**

Roses and Flowers: Azaleas, Carnations, Gladioli, Lilac	Aphids, Lace Bugs, Leaf Miners (Dipterous), Mites, Thrips, Whiteflies	4 tbsp. (2 fl. oz.) in 3 gals. water. Apply as a thorough foliar spray.	Wet the plants to the dripping point. Try to hit the underside of leaves and penetrate dense foliage.

Nuisance Pests: In Outdoor Areas.	Ants**, Box Elder Bugs, Chiggers, Clover Mites**, Cockroaches, Earwigs**, Fleas**, Flies, Millipedes**, Scorpions, Sowbugs (Pillbugs)**, Spiders, Ticks	1 pt. in 3 gal. water.**Spray 5 ft. band of soil around the house next to the foundation and the house to a height of 2-3 feet.	Thoroughly spray window and door frames, screens, foundations, porch and patio walls and ceilings, entranceways, walks, garbage cans, tree trunks and into cracks and other places where the insects can hide. <b>Do not treat plants or animals.</b>
