STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

Swallowed— Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. Do not induce vomiting unless other treatment is not available. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If it is necessary to induce vomiting, give victim one or two glasses of water and insert finger in back of throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Inhaled— Remove victim to fresh air. Apply respiration if indicated.

on Skin— Remove contaminated clothing and wash immediately with soap and water.

in Eyes— Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician immediately.

Imported Fire Ants. To aid in the control of Imported Fire Ants in lawns and other recreation areas, apply 2 fl. ozs. (4 tbsp.) in a minimum of 1 gal. water as a drench. Apply gently to avoid disturbing ants. Reapply as necessary. Larger quantities of solution can be prepared for multiple mound treatments. Use equipment capable of delivering the diluted product as a gentle rain at the rate of 1 gal. per mound. High pressure sprays may disturb the ants and cause migration, reducing product effectiveness.

NOTE: For best results, apply in cool weather, 65°-85° F., or in early morning or late evening hours. Treat new mounds as they appear.

Keep children and pets off treated areas until spray has dried.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container bottle. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
