
Subject: Revisions Per PR 2001-1 and 2001-6 and changes to Precautionary Statements and Re-entry Restrictions
Product: Sprakil D-8 Granular Weed Killer
EPA Regulation Number: 34913-4
Submission Date: 08/26/03

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended is acceptable, provided you make the following changes before you release the product for shipment.

1. In the STORAGE AND DISPOSAL section, add a "Pesticide Storage" subheading before the disposal instructions that details specific information about the storage of the pesticide. For example, "Pesticide Storage: Store in dry area where the container is not likely to come into contact with moisture. Do not store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides."
2. The order of the First Aid statements and the order of the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals statements should correspond, with the most severe routes of exposure listed first. The HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS section should be changed to "Causes moderate eye irritation. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling."
3. In the PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS section, change "waterproof gloves" to "Chemical resistant gloves made of any waterproof material."
4. The ENTRY RESTRICTIONS could be placed in the Directions for Use section.
5. In the DIRECTIONS FOR USE, add a statement that describes the maximum amount of product that can be used to treat an area per year.

Submit three (3) copies of final printed labeling incorporating the above changes before you release the product for shipment. Amended labeling will supercede all previously accepted labels. A stamped copy of labeling is enclosed for your records.

NON-CROP WEED CONTROL - INDUSTRIAL USE ONLY

Sprakil D-8 is a non-selective herbicide for controlling a wide range of annual and perennial weeds and grasses. It is recommended only for noncropland areas such as railroad, utility, and highway right-of ways and industrial areas. 200 to 400 pound applications of Sprakil D-8 per acre usually result in a nonproductive condition of the soil for a period of a year or more. The duration of non-productivity is dependent upon rainfall, soil type and other conditions.

Sprakil D-8 should be applied as furnished with a seed spreader, a fertilizer spreader, or with any equipment which will distribute the chemical uniformly over the area to be treated. For the control of annual and most perennial weeds and grasses, apply Sprakil D-8 at the rate of 200 to 400 pounds per acre; on small plots, 1/2 to 1 pound per 100 square feet. Repeat spot treatment may be required when deep rooted perennial weeds are present. To obtain the best results, Sprakil D-8 should be applied to the ground where it will be absorbed by the roots. Applications made early in the season have been found to give results superior to applications at a later seasonal date. Sprakil D-8 may, however, be applied at any time of the year except when the ground is frozen. Maximum effectiveness in arid regions is obtained when application is made just prior to the rainy season. Users

should consult state agricultural experimental stations or extension service weed specialists for recommendations as to use in their particular area.

IMPORTANT: Do not apply on or near valuable woody or herbaceous plants or on areas where their roots may extend because of possible injury to such plants. Thoroughly clean spreading equipment with a suitable chemical cleaner before using for other purposes (or do not use same spreading equipment for other purposes). Dispose of rinsate according to "Disposal" instructions found under "Storage and Disposal" heading. Do not use on croplands or any land to be used for subsequent cropping. Keep animals off treated areas.
