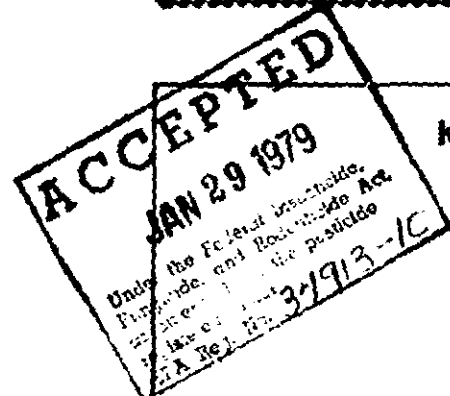

Sprakil S-5 Granular is a non-selective herbicide for controlling a wide range of annual and perennial weeds and grasses. It is recommended only for non-cropland areas such as, AIRPORT RUNWAYS, UTILITY SUBSTATIONS, TANK FARM, RAILWAY ROADBEDS AND BALLAST, ROAD SHOULDERS, NO VEGETATION IS DESIRED, UNDER ASPHALT AND STE PAVEMENTS, AROUND INDUSTRIAL BUILDING, YARDS, RAILROAD YARDS, AT THE BASE OF GUARDRAILS, SIGNPOSTS AND MARKERS AND AT THE BASE OF TRANSMISSION TOWERS AND POLES for control of most annual and perennial grasses and broadleaved weeds. Effects are slow to appear and will not become apparent until the chemical has been carried into the root zone of the weeds by moisture. The effectiveness and length of time control will last depend on texture of soil, amount of rain, and other conditions.

HOW TO APPLY: Use a mechanical spreader or other device which will spread the required amount evenly over the area to be treated. It may be applied when top growth is dense but better control will be obtained when weeds are short or when excess growth is mowed and removed before applying.

WHEN TO APPLY: Best results will be obtained if applied shortly before or at the time plant growth begins. Rains or thorough watering after application will cause the material to move to the root zone and thus speed up control. Do not use when ground is frozen.
