NON-CROP WEED CONTROL - INDUSTRIAL USE ONLY

KnockOut is a non-selective herbicide for controlling a wide range of annual and perennial weeds and grasses. It is recommended only for non cropland areas such as railroad, utility and highway rights-of-way, and industrial areas. 200 to 400 pound applications of KnockOut per acre usually result in nonproductive condition of the soil for a period of a year or more. The duration of weed control and non-productivity of the soil is dependent upon rate used, rainfall, soil type, soil pH, soil organic matter and other conditions.

KnockOut granule should be applied as furnished with a seed spreader, a fertilizer spreader, or with any equipment which will distribute the chemical uniformly over the area to be treated. For the control of annual and most perennial weeds and grasses, apply KnockOut at a rate of 200 to 400 pounds per acre; on small plots 1/2 to 1 pound per 100 square feet. Repeat spot treatment may be required when deep rooted perennial weeds are present. To obtain best results, KnockOut should be applied to the ground where it will be absorbed by the roots. Applications made early in the season have been found to give results superior to applications at a later seasonal date. KnockOut may, however, be applied at any time of the year except when the ground is frozen. Maximum effectiveness in arid regions is obtained when application is made just prior to the rainy season. Rate selection is based on weed species, weed size, and soil texture. Use the higher

rates on established plants and on fine textured soils and lower rates on smaller weeds and coarse textured soils. Users should consult state agricultural experiment stations or extension service weed specialists for recommendations as to use in their particular area.

IMPORTANT: Do not apply on or near desirable woody or herbaceous plants or on areas where their roots may extend because of possible injury to such plants. The spreading equipment should not be used for other than noncrop applications. Do not contaminate irrigation ditches or water used for domestic purposes. Do not treat powdery, dry solid or light, sandy soils when there is little likelihood of rainfall soon after treat; in areas where sensitive crops are grown, do not apply KnockOut to steep banks or treat before soil has been settled by rain as off-target movement by wind or water may occur. Do not apply to impervious substrates or when ground is frozen. Do not apply where runoff water may flow onto agricultural land, as injury to crops may result.
