Weed Blast 4-G is a nonselective herbicide for controlling a wide range of annual and perennial weeds and grasses. It is registered for industrial use only such as reinroad, utility and highway rights-or-way, 200 to 400 pound applications of Weed Blast 4-G per sere usually result in a nonproductive condition of the soci for a period of a year or more. The maximum use rate of Weed Blast 4-G is 600 lbs. of product per acre per year or 1.3 lbs. per 100 square feel per year. The durabon of nonproductivity is dependent upon rainfall, soil type, and other conditions.

Weed Bast A-G should be applied as furnished with a seed spreador, a lerivizer spreader, or with any equipment which will distribute the chemical uniformly over the area to be treated. For the control of annual and most perennial weeds and grasses, apply Weed Blast A-G at the rate of 200 to 400 pounds per acre, on smaller plots, 1/2 to 1 pound per 100 equare feet.
