Weed Blast 8-G is a nonselective herbicide for controlling a wide range of annual and perennial weeds and grasses. It is recommended only for non-cropland areas such as railroad, utility and highway rights-of-way, and industrial areas. 100 to 200 pound applications of Weed Blast 8-G per acre usually result in a nonproductive condition of the soil for a period of a year or more. The duration of nonproductivity is dependent upon rainfall, soil types, and other conditions.

Weed Blast 8-G should be applied as directed with a seed spreader, a fertilizer spreader, or with any equipment which will distribute the chemical uniformly over the area to be treated.
