TO KILL DRYWOOD TERMITES

Insert the needle into the termite hole. Usually, drywood termites seal their hole with a plug that is the same color as the wood they are eating. Look for a spot about the diameter of the needle (on the hose attachment) that could be plugged up hole. Push the needle through the plug and spray. **DO NOT FORCE THE NEEDLE BECAUSE IT MAY CLOG OR BREAK. IF NECESSARY, ENLARGE THE TERMITE HOLE WITH AN ICE PICK SO THAT THE NEEDLE MAY ENTER FREELY.** Additionally, locate hollow areas by tapping. Use an ice pick or nail to make a hole for the needle. Insert the needle and spray for 5 seconds or until spray mist appears at the entry point or at another point in the wood. Inspect at six months and one year to insure that the entire colony has been killed.

TO KILL COCKROACHES

Use the needle to spray into cracks and crevices: behind wall boards, beneath and behind appliances and into other places where roaches may hide and breed. Apply the spray directly to the insects if possible. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL ANTS

Spray directly on the ants contacting as many as possible with the spray. Spray ant trails and entry points around doors and windows. Follow ants back to their nest if possible. Insert the needle into the nest opening and spray. Repeat as necessary.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARD TO HUMANS AND PETS: CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Brief irritation and tearing may occur. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. FOOD PRECAUTIONARY

Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is under way. After spraying in food processing plants, wash all equipment with potable water, benches, shelving etc., where exposed food will be handled. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Flammable: Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator. May harm some plastics and finishes.

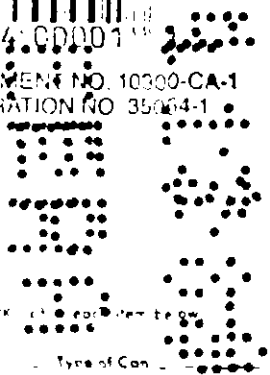
DISPOSAL
