DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING. FOR CRACK AND CREVICE OR SPOT TREATMENT ONLY. TO KILL DRYWOOD TERMITES

Locate the termite hole. Termites seal their hole with a plug that is the same, or darker color than the wood they are eating. Look for a spot (about the size of a small pin head) that could be a plugged up hole. Push the needle through this plug. **DO NOT FORCE THE NEEDLE. IF NECESSARY, ENLARGE THE TERMITE HOLE WITH AN ICE PICK.** If you can't locate the termite hole, locate hollow areas by tapping the wood with a small hard object and then make a hole into the hollow with an ice pick or a 1/16" drill. Spray into the termite hole or drilled hole until you see the insecticide coming out the entry hole or some other place in the wood, but never spray in any hole longer than 30 seconds. (CAUTION: make sure spray is not filling up some adjacent room, closet or cabinet.) Inspect for droppings at six months and one year to insure the colony has been killed.

TO KILL COCKROACHES

Use the needle to spray into the roach's home; cracks, hollow doors; behind loose base boards; between the inside and outside walls of appliances and into other small places where roaches live. Repeat as necessary. (IMPORTANT NOTE: ROACHES WILL HIDE AND DIE IN PRIVATE AFTER BEING SPRAYED WITH TERM-OUT, SO YOU MAY NOT SEE DEAD ROACHES.)

TO KILL ANTS

Follow the ant trail back to a hole in the wall or the ant nest. Insert the needle into the hole or ant nest and spray. Sponge the full length of the ant trail with a damp soapy sponge (this removes the ants' scent trail and kills the ants). Repeat as necessary.

FOOD PRECAUTIONARY

After spraying in food processing plants, wash all equipment (benches, shelving, etc.) where food will be handled with an effective cleaning compound, followed by a potable water rinse. In the home; all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use.

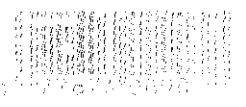
PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

TERM-OUT

ANTS

TERM-OUT has a 14" flexible extension tube with a 1/4" diameter injector tip and soft pad. The pad seals holes, reduces leakage and insecticide spray back. Spray back occurs when pressure builds up in closed-off holes or from connected exit holes of termite tunnels. Before spraying, be sure spray head and spray tip opening are pointed away from humans and pets.

Roaches hide in dark, cramped spaces when lights are on. Roach eggs look like brown beans attached to walls or objects. Check for other in cluttered areas or objects that are not disturbed often and have small openings or hollow spaces. Portable appliances, hollow cabinet doors, drawer bottoms, piles of paper, bathroom scales and fixtures can be home for roaches. Treat as necessary.
