

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

DANGER

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Aqua Pure Algaecide Swimming Pool Treatment for control of Green, Blue Green, and other resistant forms of Algae (yellow), and other resistant forms of Algae control.

Initial Dose: When pool has visible algae, add 1 quart (32 oz.) of Aqua Pure Algaecide per 10,000 gallons of pool water by distributing around perimeter. One half hour (30 minutes) after application, add three gallons (3 Gals.) of Calcium Hypochlorite or equivalent of chlorine, per 10,000 gals. water. Add Algaecide to water by itself, do not mix with other pool chemicals. Aqua Pure is for use at dilutions to inanimate surfaces.

Discontinue swimming until chlorine residual is maintained. Keep filter system operating continuously after treatment.

Backwash filter as required and brush vacuum pool before and after algae treatment.

Maintenance dose (pool is free of visible algae): 4 oz. Aqua Pure Algaecide per 20,000 gallons of water every two weeks during the swimming season.

Maintain pH of pool water in the range of 7.2 to 7.6 and maintain correct chlorine residual.

Each graduation on side of bottle represents approximately 2 oz.
