

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Wear a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mining Enforcement and Safety Administration and the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health under the provisions of 30 CFR Part 11. Contains petroleum distillate. If swallowed do not induce vomiting. Get immediate medical attention. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

Do not apply directly to food. Do not apply space spray while food processing is underway. Cover or remove all food processing surfaces. Thoroughly wash all food processing surfaces before re use. After spraying in meat packing plants, bakeries and the food processing plants, wash with potable water all equipment, benches, shelving, etc. where exposed food will be handled.

Food processing operations must be stopped while applying a wet spray with care and in accordance with the directions and cautions given above.

When using in animal housing areas, do not apply directly to food, water or feed supplements. Do not apply directly to animals. Wash teats of dairy animals before milking.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Do not store near heat or open flame.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

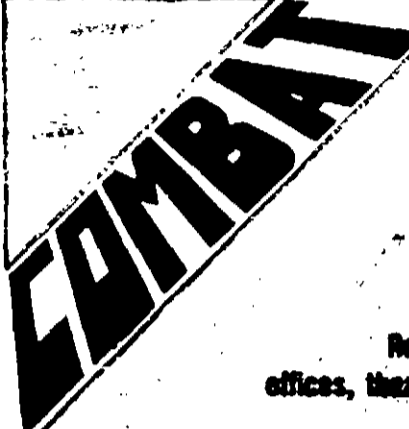
Storage: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide or rinsate that cannot be used or chemically processed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

Container Disposal:

- a) Containers of 30 gallons or more—reseal container and offer for reconditioning, or
- b) All containers—triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling, reconditioning or disposal in approved landfill.

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General: This product is designed for use and use in mechanical sprayers which produce particles of aerosol size such as the LECOL or MICRO GEN.

Note: When used in hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate for two hours after treatment. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

FOR USE IN HOMES, RESTAURANTS, FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS AND OTHER INDUSTRIAL AREAS.

Space Spray Undiluted: To Kill Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Small Flying Moths: Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilating equipment. Using a cold fog generator, apply at the rate of one half (1/2) ounce per 1,000 cu. ft. of space. Direct output from aerosol generator upwards toward upper corners of room and ceiling. Leave room closed for one half hour. Ventilate room thoroughly before re entry. Repeat as necessary.

Space Spray—Diluted for Ordinary Mechanical Fogging Equipment—To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Gnats: Cover or remove exposed food and food handling surfaces. Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilating equipment. Dilute Concentrate with oil at the rate of 1 part Concentrate plus 29 parts of oil and mix well. Apply at the rate of 50 fl. oz. of dilute spray (4 gal.) per 25,000 cu. ft. of space. Direct fog upward towards upper corners of room and ceiling area. Leave room closed for 1/2 hour. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate room thoroughly before re entry.

Contact Spray—Undiluted—To Kill Cockroaches, Rice Weevils, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Confused Flour Beetles, Black Carpet Beetles and Indian Meal Moth Larvae: Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilation equipment. Using a cold fog aerosol generator, direct discharge into areas suspected of harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. Spray until treated surfaces are moist with deposit. Leave room closed for one half hour. Ventilate room thoroughly before re entry. Repeat as necessary.

Contact Spray—Diluted for Use with Sprayers that Give Large Wetting Spray Particles to Kill Cockroaches and Accessible Stages of Granary Insects: Granary Weevils, Rice Weevils, Confused Flour Beetles, Rusty Grain Beetles, Red Flour Beetles, Indian Meal Moth Larvae and Adults, Cadellus, Grain Mites and Sawtoothed Grain Beetles: Cover or remove exposed food and close room and described above. Dilute Concentrate with oil at the rate of 1 part Concentrate plus 29 parts of oil and mix well. Spray outside walls of grain bins, flooring, about base of milling machinery, walls and baseboards, areas behind cabinets, around pipes and other insect harbourages using 1 gal. of spray per 1,000 sq. ft. of surface. Force spray into all cracks and crevices. Repeat applications as necessary.

FOR USE IN DAIRY AND BEEF BARNS, SWINE HOUSING: Space Spray—Diluted for Use in Aerosol Generators to Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths and Exposed Cockroaches: Cover or remove exposed food and watering troughs and close house as tightly as possible. Dilute Concentrate with refined kerosene at the rate of 1 part Concentrate plus 5 parts of oil and mix well. Direct spray upward and apply until room is filled with mist. Keep closed for 1/2 hour and ventilate thoroughly prior to re entry.

Space Spray—Diluted for Ordinary Mechanical Fogging Equipment to Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Gnats: Prepare for application as above. Dilute Concentrate with refined kerosene at the rate of 1 part Concentrate plus 29 parts of refined kerosene and mix well. Apply at the rate of 50 fl. oz. dilute spray (4 gal.) per 25,000 cu. ft. of space above animals. Direct fog upward toward upper corners of room and ceiling. Vacate room and leave closed for 1/2 hour.
