FOR SPACE SPRAY

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Gnats and Wasps: Spray in cracks and windows and other spray-down areas. Hold container upright and spray downward. Do not spray directly at people or animals. Do not use in occupied rooms. Do not use in areas where food is prepared or stored. Do not use in areas where children play. Do not use in areas where pets are kept.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants and Crickets: Control as follows: Spray with the spray in cracks and crevices, under furniture, behind baseboards, and in other areas where they hide. Do not spray directly at people or animals. Do not use in areas where food is prepared or stored. Do not use in areas where children play. Do not use in areas where pets are kept.

To Kill Carpet Beetles: The spray primarily targets exposed areas. Spray in cracks and under furniture. Do not spray directly at people or animals. Do not use in areas where food is prepared or stored. Do not use in areas where children play. Do not use in areas where pets are kept.

To Kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks: Spray on and spray pits of dogs. Do not spray directly at people or animals. Do not use in areas where food is prepared or stored. Do not use in areas where children play. Do not use in areas where pets are kept.

FOR CRACK and CREVICE

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Brown Dog Ticks, Fleas and Carpet Beetles: Apply spray in cracks and crevices. Do not spray directly at people or animals. Do not use in areas where food is prepared or stored. Do not use in areas where children play. Do not use in areas where pets are kept.
