

Use clean water. When used as a space spray dilute by adding 1 part concentrate to 27 parts water. Stir and mix well. 2 gallons of concentrate makes 55 gallons of ready to use insecticide.

READY TO USE DILUTIONS:

.05% Add 3.2 ounces to 1 gallon of water.

.07% Add 5.2 ounces to 1 gallon of water.

.10% Add 6.4 ounces to 1 gallon of water.

OUTDOOR USE

For use outside homes, patios, tennis courts, pool areas, restaurants, and in horse barns, kennels, dairy barns, zoo animal quarters, cattle feed lots, hog confinement areas.

Use as a space spray to control house flies, stable flies, horse flies, fruit flies, deer flies, horn flies, mosquitoes, gnats, bott flies, face flies, fleas, wasp and spiders.

APPLICATION

To apply as a space spray use mechanical spray equipment (non thermal). Set spray nozzle to deliver a fine mist. Direct spray to distribute evenly throughout the entire area at a rate of 1 ounce per 1000 cubic feet of space.
