# Directions for use GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

BREWERIES: Filter Mass - prerinse with cold water. Shut off water and raise temperature to 140° F. Add one pound of HALO-540 to each 80 gallons of water. Run washer 30 minutes, then rinse with cold water.

#### RUBBER AND METAL BEER LINES:

After prerinsing, circulate HALO-540 solution (15 lbs. HALO-540 in 100 gals, water) for one hour. Rinse with cold water for 15 minutes.
