The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended is acceptable, provided you make the following changes before you release the product for shipment.

- 1. Add an "If Inhaled" section to the First Aid statements after If Swallowed, with the following text: If Inhaled:
- -Move person to fresh air.
- -If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth if possible.
- -Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice

Submit three (3) copies of final printed labeling incorporating the above changes before you release the product for shipment. Amended labeling will supercede all previously accepted ones. A stamped copy of labeling is enclosed for your records.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Atrazine can travel (seep or leach) through soil and can enter ground water, which may be used as drinking water. Atrazine has been found in ground water. Users are advised not to apply Atrazine to sand and loamy soils where the water table (ground water) is close to the surface and where these soils are very permeable, i.e. well drained. Your local agricultural agencies can provide further information on the type of soil in your area and the location of ground water. This product is toxic to aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. watering) until the watering-in is complete and the surface is dry. APPLICATION EQUIPMENT RESTRICTIONS

Do not apply granular lawn products by hand, do not allow product to come in contact with hands. Granular tawn products applied by hand-held devices (e.g., belly grinder) can only be applied as a spot treatment.

WHEN TO APPLY

Best weed control will result if applied before weeds sprout since the product acts as a Pre-Emergent AND also as a Post Emergent weed killer.

Established weeds are harder to kill and may require an additional application in the fall or spring. Apply January 1th up to March 1th for best control otherwise product may be applied up to June 15th with good weed control. A fall application will be needed for control of certain annuals such as Chickweed, Henbit, Rabbit Tobacco, Florida Betony and Evening Primrose.

In case of heavy weed infestation or low soil moisture, a repeated application may be necessary. Kill time of mature weeds may be 4 to 5 weeks. Wait 2 months for repeat application. Apply when air is calm to prevent particle wind drift.

HOW TO APPLY

This product may be applied with either a drop type or broadcast type spreader. Apply evenly across the entire lawn at a rate of 50 lb.bag to treat 8,800 Sq. Ft. - 25 lb. bag treats 4,400 Sq. Ft. of lawn. (equivalent to 5.7 lbs. per 1,000 Sq. Ft.). Do not exceed recommended rates. Water immediately after application to wash granules off the grass hlades

HOW TO SET YOUR SPREADER

CYCLONE 4 SCOTT 6

NOTE: Spreader rate varies with walking speed. Check spreader over known area.

WHERE TO USE

This material is for use on St. Augustine and Centipede lawns only. Do not use on Bluegrass, Fescue, Bentgrass, Bahia, Rye, Bermuda, or Dichondra lawns. On newly seeded centipede, wait until grass has been mowed at least once. Do not plant "sprigs" within one month after application, or seed within 6 months after application. Do not plant any crop (flower or vegetable gardens) to treated areas for 18 months or injury may result. Apply this product only when grass blades are dry.

USE PRECAUTIONS

Do not apply this product on or over the root zone of ornamental trees and shrubs, nor to bedding plants, flowers, or garden plants since injury to these plants my result. Do not apply to lawns containing grasses or mixtures of grasses other than those listed on the label or injury to these grasses may result.
