A fall application will be needed for control of certain annuals such as Chickweed, Henbit, Rabbit Tobacco. Florida Betony and Evening Primrose. In case of heavy weed infestation or low soil moisture, a repeated

application may be necessary. Time for complete kill of mature weeds may be 4 to 5 weeks. Wait 2 months for repeat application. Apply when air is calm to prevent particle wind drift.

This product may be applied with either a drop type or broadcast type spreader. Apply evenly across the entire lawn at a rate of 50 pounds to treat 10,000 Sq.Ft. — 40 lbs. to treat 8,000 sq.ft. of lawn. (equivalent to 5 lbs. per 1,000 Sq.Ft). Do not exceed recommended rates.
