CARPET BEETLES:

Spray edges of carpeting and under carpeting and rugs. Make localized application to the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks, closets and infested areas of shelving. Repeat as necessary.

BROWN DOG TICKS:

Thoroughly spray sleeping quarters of animals. Spray infested areas around windows, door frames and wallcoverings. Applications should be repeated as necessary. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. DO NOT TREAT ANIMALS WITH THIS FORMULATION.

OUTDOOR USE

Precautions: (1) Spray with wind to your back. If clothing becomes wet from spray during use, remove clothing after spraying, wash affected body areas thoroughly with soap and water and launder clothing before wearing again. (2) Do not allow children or pets to contact treated areas until spray has dried. (3) Do not apply to lawns or other desirable plants.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, WASPS, AND SMALL FLYING MOTHS: For outdoor use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors,

room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages, and other places where these insects alight or congregate.

FLEAS, CHIGGERS AND ANTS:

For treatment of localized infestations of these insects in outdoor areas around the home only, spray infested areas. Do not apply to lawns or other desirable plants. Do not spray fruit or vegetable plants with this product. For ants, wet hills and runways. Repeat as necessary.
