


It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To inhibit growth of microorganisms, use one ounce (30 mL) of DIESEL STA-BIL® for every 31.25 gallons of diesel fuel or heating oil. As a preventive treatment, use one half ounce (15 mL) for every 31.25 gallons. In hot, humid weather, treat all fuel with DIESEL STA-BIL® to protect against injector and filter clogging and control of microbial growth.

FOR TREATMENT OF BULK DIESEL FUEL STORAGE TANKS - Never treat an empty tank. Direct contact of DIESEL STA-BIL® with water phase must be avoided. DIESEL STA-BIL® must be blended into the fuel phase only and not into the water phase at the bottom of the tank. Add DIESEL STA-BIL® when tank is at least half full. DIESEL STA-BIL® is soluble in both fuel and water; it is designed to migrate from the fuel phase to the water phase for control of fungus.

FOR TREATMENT OF DIESEL EQUIPMENT FUEL TANK - Use the same treatment level as above. Run engine 10-15 minutes to ensure complete blending and to allow movement of treated fuel through the injection equipment.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

STORAGE: DIESEL STA-BIL® should be protected from moisture. Containers must be capped tightly when not in use as prolonged exposure to atmospheric moisture can cause formation of solids and loss of effectiveness. Do not transfer to other containers for storage. Discard if product is cloudy or contains solid materials.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal law.
