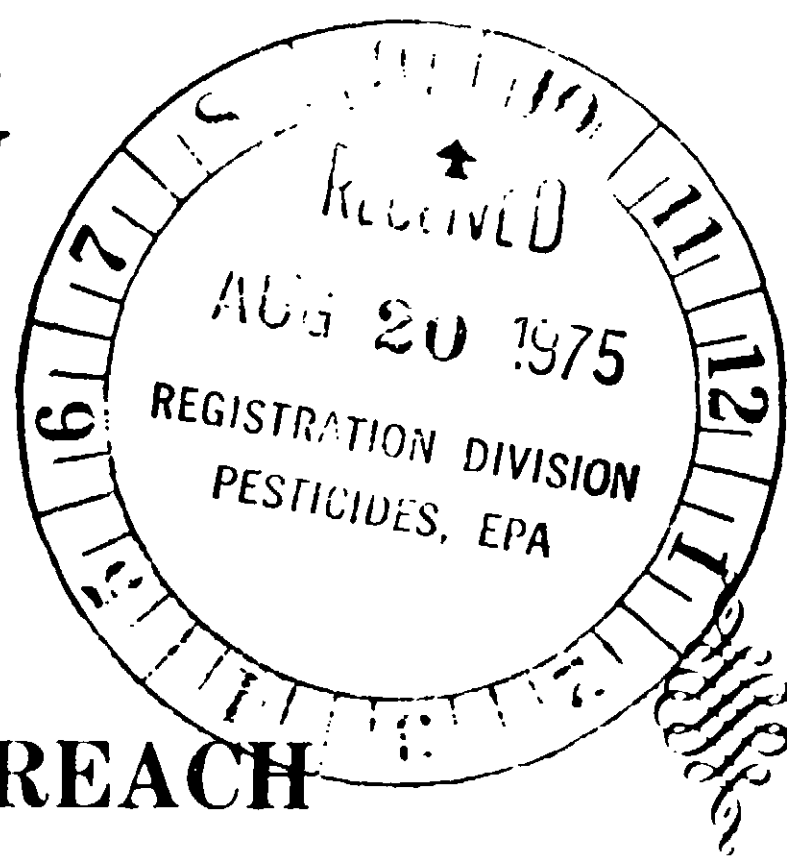

— DIRECTIONS —

For use in commercial food and drink establishments where chemical control facilities are maintained to prevent the concentration of available chlorine from falling below 50 parts per million (ppm). An initial starting concentration of available chlorine in the rinse sink must be 100 ppm. To achieve 100 ppm, simply dissolve one (1) MR. O'S tablet in three gallons of warm water. Do not allow the chlorine concentration to fall below 50 ppm as determined by a suitable chlorine test kit. In the absence of using a chlorine test kit, start with the required 100 ppm available chlorine and change the solution frequently or after each use. Immerse utensils in solution for one-half minute. No further rinsing is necessary.

— DANGER —

WARNING: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

CORROSIVE. Causes eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust. May cause burns to broken skin. Wash hands after handling.

FIRST AID: If swallowed feed gruel, cooked cereal, or bread soaked in milk, followed by olive oil or cooking oil. In case of personal contact, remove excess material and flush skin or eyes with cold water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes get medical attention. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

WARNING: STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT

Mix only with water. Use clean dry utensils. Contamination by moisture, organic matter, or other chemicals may liberate hazardous gases. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. Decomposes at 350-475 degrees F with liberation of harmful gases. In case of decomposition, if possible, isolate container in open air. Flood with large amounts of water. Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Do not reuse empty container. Destroy it by perforating or crushing. Bury or discard in a safe place away from water supplies.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds, or public waters. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on the label.

Use as directed on label. For general household use, use 1 tablet per gallon of water. For use in food service, use 2 tablets per gallon of water. For use in public buildings, use 4 tablets per gallon of water. For use in industrial applications, use 8 tablets per gallon of water. For use in swimming pools, use 1 tablet per 10,000 gallons of water. For use in hot tubs, use 1 tablet per 100 gallons of water. For use in laundry, use 1 tablet per load of laundry. For use in toilet bowls, use 1 tablet per bowl. For use in sinks, use 1 tablet per sink. For use in showers, use 1 tablet per shower. For use in bathtubs, use 1 tablet per bathtub.
