**CAUTION**

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. **General:** Use this product as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, waterbugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas and other insects listed below. Apply as a coarse spray to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.

**Applications in and around the home:** Use as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control Cockroaches, Ants, Crickets, Silverfish, Bowbugs, Spiders and Earwigs. Apply this product as a coarse spray to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, around baseboards and in and around waste containers. Spray surfaces until wet. Contact as many insects as possible. For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises. Repeat as necessary for control.

**To Kill Carpet Beetles and Dermestids:** Spray along baseboards, edges of carpeting, under carpets and rugs, under furniture and in other places of harborage.

**To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas:** Remove and destroy old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spray has dried. Do not spray animals. To control the source of your flea infestation treat your pet with a product registered for application to animals.

**Application within food handling establishments (places other than private residences in which food is held, processed, prepared or served) including, but not limited to, restaurants, grocery stores, bakeries, building plants, canneries and grain mills:** to kill ants, roaches, crickets, silverfish, bowbugs, spiders, earwigs, brown dog ticks, fleas, carpet beetles and dermestids. Use as a spot treatment to localized areas where the above pests have been seen or are suspected of hiding or entering. Apply only enough spray to thoroughly cover the surfaces treated, using special care to avoid unnecessary runoff. Do not introduce the spray into the air or allow the spray to contact food or food-contacting surfaces. Areas treated may include dark corners of rooms and closets, along and behind baseboards; beneath and behind stoves, refrigeration units, floor drains and plumbing.
