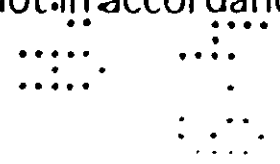

This is in response to your amendment to update/revise your label according to recommendations provided by your supplier (Buckman Laboratories).

The labeling referred to above submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended is acceptable provided that you make the following revisions before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. Place "Keep Out of Reach of Children" immediately above the signal word "Caution".
2. Revise ingestion statement to read "If swallowed, call a physician or poison control center. Do not induce vomiting. Rinse mouth with copious amounts of water, and then give 1 or 2 glasses of water. Avoid alcohol."
3. Change the heading "First Aid" to read "Statement of Practical Treatment (First Aid)".
4. Revise the Environmental Hazards to read as follows:

"This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in
