Dear Mr. Miller:

The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as amended is acceptable provided the following changes are made:

1. Delete the Spanish signal word "PELIGRO" and the following Spanish language statement "Si usted no entiende .... to you in detail". This product is not subject to WPS labeling requirements.

# 2. In the section HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

- a. Delete the Spanish signal word "PELIGRO"
- b. Replace the sentence "May cause skin ... individuals" with "Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals."
- c. Replace "Avoid contact ... on clothing" with "Do not get in eyes, skin or clothing. Wear protective eyewear." Then add "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse."
- 3. In the section **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**, delete the statements beginning with "This product is toxic to fish..." and ending "...equipment washwater."

# 4. In the section **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**:

- a. Move the sentence "Do not contaminate water ... or disposal" to directly under the section header.
- b. Move the sentence "Open dumping is prohibited" to the **Pesticide Disposal** section.

- c. Move the sentence "Do not reuse empty container" to the **Container Disposal** section
- d. Change the subheader Storage to "Pesticide Storage"
- e. Add recommended storage instructions after the subheader "Pesticide Storage"
