General Comments:

1. In accordance with PR Notice 2001-1, the following statement must be added at the bottom of the first aid statement:

"Have the product container or label with you when calling a Poison Control Center or Doctor or going for treatment."
2. The EPA encourages registrants to add the following information (telephone#) at the bottom of the first aid statement:


