The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as amended is acceptable provided the following change is made:

1. In the First Aid block, the "If in eyes" statements must be listed first.

Note: You may delete the Spanish signal word "Peligro" and the statements "Si usted ... in detail" from the front panel and the Precautionary statements. This warning is not required for manufacturing use products since these type of products are not subject to the Worker Protection Standards (WPS). We regret this was overlooked in our previous review of the label.

One copy of the label stamped "Accepted with comments" is enclosed for your records. Please submit one copy of the final printed label before the product is released for shipment.
