Or, alternatively, delete the "Get medical attention..." sentence, add the "Call a poison...for advice." after the last of the "IF..." subsections, and delete this latter sentence in the "IF INHALED:" and "IF IN EYES:" subsections.

e. In the "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS" section, in the first sentence, add the word "other" so that the sentence reads "This product is toxic to fish and other aquatic organisms."

f. In the "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" section, after the first sentence ("Do not contaminate...or disposal.") add the subsection header "PESTICIDE STORAGE" and instructions for the proper storage of the product.

g. In the "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" section, after the "PESTICIDE STORAGE" subsection that was added in 2.f. above, add the subsection header "PESTICIDE DISPOSAL" before the sentence "Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous."

h. In the "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" section, in the text in what is presently line 4, change "you" to "your" so the sentence reads "...contact your State Pesticide....".

3. Submit one copy of your final printed label before you release this product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

### FIRST AID

**IF SWALLOWED:**

Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.

##### **DANGER - PELIGRO**
