Revise the first statement in the last paragraph of Enclosure III, p. 28, to read "There are no additional restrictions or precautions for your concern if you use the product in accordance with the labeling instructions." Also, insert the word only between "use" and "on" in the last statement on this same page.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.
