FOR GENERAL IONICS MODEL DWC 1500
BACTERIOSTATIC DRINKING WATER CONDITIONER

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of the Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. Turn off the water to the unit by turning the saddle valve handle all the way clockwise.
2. Release the water pressure by depressing the red pressure relief button on the head of the cartridge housing.
3. Unscrew sump and remove expended cartridge. Wrap spent cartridge in newspaper and discard with trash.
4. Rinse out the sump and fill about 1/2 full with water and add one to two capfulls of 5% household bleach. Scrub with brush or sponge. Rinse thoroughly.
5. Insert new HY-10 HYgene Replacement Cartridge into sump. Screw the sump back onto the head and tighten securely. Make sure "O" ring seal between sump and cap is properly lubricated and seated.
6. Open the saddle valve 1/4 turn and depress the red pressure relief button until all the air has escaped.
7. Fully open saddle valve and check for leaks.
8. Open delivery faucet and flush conditioner for 15 minutes. Unit is now in service.
