1. Users are required to wear long sleeve shirts and long pants or equivalent, chemical resistant gloves, and boots (waterproofed). In addition, persons involved in mixing/loading operations are required to use heavy-duty chemical resistant gloves or neoprene gloves and a face shield or goggles.
2. Restricted Use Pesticide – (Ground and Surface Water Concerns)
For retail to and use only by certified applicators or persons under direct supervision, and only for those uses covered by the certified applicator's certification.
This product is a restricted use herbicide due to ground and surface water concerns. Users must read and follow all precautionary statements and instructions for use in order to minimize potential for atrazine to reach ground and surface water.
3. Ground water contamination may be reduced by diking and flooring of permanent liquid bulk storage sites with an impenetrable material.
4. This product may not be mixed/loaded or used within 50 feet of all wells, including abandoned wells, drainage wells, and sink holes. This product may not be mixed or loaded within 50 feet of intermittent streams and rivers, natural or impounded lakes and reservoirs. This product may not be applied aerially or by ground within 66 feet of the points where field surface water runoff enters perennial or intermittent streams and rivers or within 200 ft. around natural or impounded lakes and reservoirs. If this product is applied to highly erodible land, the 66 foot buffer or setback from runoff entry points must be planted to crop, seeded with grass or other suitable crop.
5. Postemergence application to corn and sorghum must be made before corn and sorghum reaches 12 inches in height.
6. Applications for quackgrass suppression in corn and sorghum are restricted to spring application only. No fall applications are permitted.
7. A) For soil applications prior to crop emergence (i.e. early preplant, preplant incorporated, preplant surface, at planting or preemergence).
 - i) On highly erodible soils as defined by Soil Conservation Service (SCS), if conservation tillage is utilized [$\geq 30\%$ plant residue] the maximum rate is 2 pounds a.i./A. If plant residue is $< 30\%$, the maximum rate is 1.6 pounds a.i./A.
