Dear Sir:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted.

1. In the first paragraph under the product name, change "experienced" to "trained." Delete "...and in Repackaging into portable cylinders" and "Repackagers must obtain their own registration with Environmental Protection Agency." Insert "This product cannot be transferred to portable cylinders. Pool service operators with portable cylinders must obtain their own registrations with the EPA."

2. Under "FIRST AID" add "If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen, preferably with a physician's advice." Also add, "In case of skin or eye contact, immediately flush all affected areas with large amounts of running water for at least 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing and shoes. For eyes, hold eyelids apart during the flushing to ensure rinsing of the entire surface of the eye and lids with water. Call a physician immediately."

3. After "Do not get in eyes, on skin, or clothing" add "Wear goggles, protective clothing and rubber gloves when handling. Do not heat containers."

4. Under "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" add "All valves must be closed tight and closures or caps secured. It is illegal to ship a leaking chlorine container."

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
