Postemergence	1.65 fl. oz.	[Red] Potatoes: Properly timed applications of this product generally enhance red color, aid in storage retention of red color, improve skin appearance, increase tuber set, and improve tuber size uniformity (fewer jumbos). Crop response may vary depending on variety, stress factors, and local conditions. Varieties with naturally dark red color generally benefit less from treatment.

PRECAUTIONS FOR USE ON [RED] POTATOES

- Make first application when potatoes are in the pre-bud stage (about 7 to 10 inches high) and make a second application about 10 to 14 days later.
- Consult with Agricultural Extension Service and other qualified crop advisors for local recommendations.
- The specific spray volume selected should be sufficient for good coverage of plants.

RESTRICTIONS FOR USE ON [RED] POTATOES

- The preharvest interval (PHI) is 45 days.
- Minimum of 10 days between applications.
- Do not apply more than two times per year.
- Postemergence

- Limited to two postemergence application per crop cycle.
- Maximum of 1.65 fluid ounces (0.07 lb 2,4-D ae) per acre per application.
- Apply 1.65 fluid ounces of this product per acre in 2 to 25 gallons of water using ground or aerial equipment.

This supplemental label expires on March 31, 2018, and must not be used beyond that date.
