TECHNICAL PRODUCT FOR FORMULATION ONLY Act, as amnded, for the pesticide registered under:

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Early signs of intoxication include dilation of pupils, muscular incoordination, and muscular tremors. Toxicity following accidental ingestion of the technical product can be minimized by vomiting within one-half hour of exposure; rapidly after exposure (less than 15 minutes), administer repeatedly medical charcoal in a large quantity of water or pecac. If toxicity from exposure has progressed to cause severe vomiting, the extent of resultant fluid and electrolyte imbalance should be gauged. Appropriate supportive parenteral fluid replacement therapy should be given, along with other required supportive measures (such as maintenance of blood pressure levels and proper respiratory functionality) as indicated by clinical signs, symptoms, and measurements. In severe cases, observation should confinue for at least several days until clinical conditions are stable and normal. Since abamectin is believed to enhance GABA activity in animals, it is probably wise to avoid drugs that enhance GABA activity (barbiturates, benzodiazepines, valproic acid) in patients with potentially toxic abamectin exposures. There is no specific antidote. Treat other routes of exposure symptomatically.

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
