Dear Alexis Bromley:

The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Glufosinate-ammonium is a glutamine synthetase inhibitor and can interfere with neurotransmitter function. Symptoms may be delayed by up to 48 hours following ingestion. There is no specific antidote. If ingested, endotracheal intubation and gastric lavage should be performed as soon as possible followed by charcoal and sodium sulfate administration.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

DO NOT discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. **DO NOT** discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Only for formulation into an herbicide for the following uses:

- 1. Weed control of emerged weeds in noncrop areas
- 2. Control of weeds and grasses in residential and industrial areas
- 3. Weed control in citrus (Crop Group 10-10), pome fruits (Crop Group 11-10), stone fruits (Crop Group 12-12), bushberries (Crop Group 13-07B), grapes (Crop Group 13-07F) and tree nut (Crop group 14)
- 4. Weed control in bananas, and rice
- 5. Weed control in glufosinate-ammonium tolerant canola, corn, cotton, soybeans and sugar beets
- 6. For the elimination of non-glufosinate-ammonium tolerant corn, soybeans, rice and cotton plants in seed production
- 7. Uses for which the U.S. EPA has accepted the required data and/or citations of data that the formulator has submitted in support of registration
- 8. For uses not listed on the manufacturing product label if the formulator, user group or grower has complied with the U.S. EPA submission requirements regarding support of such uses
- 9. Uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with U.S. EPA requirements

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DO NOT contaminate water, foodstuffs, feed or seed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Keep container tightly closed when not in use.

CONTAINER HANDLING:

Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container 1/4 full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times.

For rigid nonrefillable containers that are too large to shake (i.e., with capacities greater than 5 gallons or 50 lbs) Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or mix tank. Fill the container 1/4 full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.

Fiber drums with liners: Nonrefillable container. **DO NOT** reuse or refill this container. Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping both sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into manufacturing equipment. Then offer fiber drum and liner for recycling, if available.
