

The active ingredient, azoxystrobin, in this product can be persistent for several months or longer. Use of this chemical in areas where soils are permeable, particularly where the water table is shallow may result in ground water contamination.

This pesticide is toxic to freshwater and estuarine/marine fish and aquatic invertebrates. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, tidal marshes or estuaries. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.
