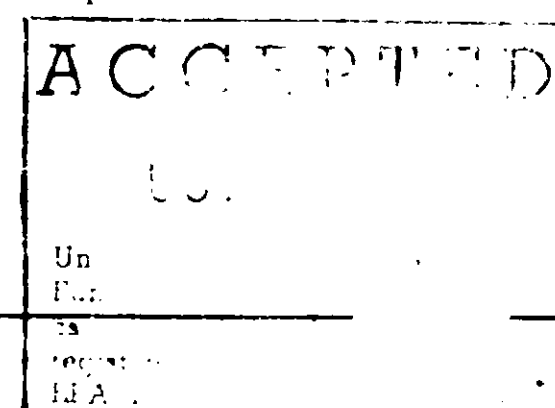

#### DIRECTIONS

Initial Application: To a clean pool or when  
filling pool at beginning of season add one  
gallon to 50,000 gallons of water, or ratio  
thereof. If pool has visible algae growth treat  
with initial dose. Vacuum pool after 24 hours  
to remove dead algae debris. If visible algae  
are still present or reappear, repeat this treat-  
ment procedure as necessary. When pool is free  
of algae use recommended maintenance dose.  
Apply to the water along pool edges.

Maintenance Dose: Use one quart per 50,000  
gallons of water every 5 to 7 days. When  
weather is hot or bathing load is heavy, use  
this dosage every 5 days or as necessary.

Booster Dose: Immediately after every rain add  
one quart per 50,000 gallons of water as  
above.

IMPORTANT: Follow above directions with-  
out fail, even when pool is not used. Algae  
growth must be fought at all times.

Pool side Surfaces: After cleaning surfaces, use  
1 oz. to four gallons of water for sanitizing or  
1 oz. to two gallons of water for disinfecting.  
Apply so as to wet surfaces thoroughly with  
recommended solutions.

#### FIRST AID:

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or  
skin with plenty of water for at least 15  
minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove  
and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.  
If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity  
of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these  
are not available, drink large quantities of  
water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician im-  
mediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal  
damage may contraindicate the use of gastric  
lavage. Measures against circulatory shock,  
respiratory depression and convulsion may be  
needed.
