

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**

**HAZARD TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**CAUTION**

May be harmful if swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapors, dust or mist. Avoid contact with the skin, eyes or clothing. **FIRST-AID**

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Keep out of lakes, ponds, and streams. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. Also toxic to bees and should not be applied when bees are actively visiting the area. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Avoid scattering in lumps. If bait is spilled, clean up area and dispose of by using or by burying. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**GRASSHOPPERS AND CRICKETS:** Apply at the rate of 5-20 lbs. per acre to and around margins of corn fields when insects first appear, preferably in the nymph state before migration starts. Retreatment may be necessary at 5 lb. rate if infestation is heavy or hoppers migrate.

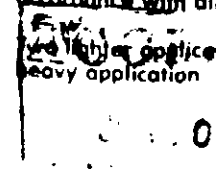
**GRASSHOPPERS, ARMYWORMS & CLIMBING CUTWORMS:** Apply at the rate of 5-10 lbs. per acre. Treat in and around margins of wheat, oats, rye, rice and barley, preferably 7 to 10 days to planting where damaging number of insects occur. Retreatment after planting may be necessary. Wet bait may be prepared by adding approximately 4 gallons of water to Border Bait to make a crumbly mash.

Do not graze dairy animals or animals being finished for slaughter, or do not feed treated forage.

Spread the bait uniformly, use a broadcasting machine, or fertilizer spreader, or aircraft, at the rate of 5-20 lbs. per acre. Most effective applications are made in morning or evening hours. Avoid scattering in lumps and piles. Injury to wildlife and livestock is likely unless uniform application is achieved.

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Light applications are better than one heavy application.



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
