GRASSHOPPERS AND CRICKETS: Apply at the rate of 5-20 lbs per acre to in and around margins of corn fields when insects first appear preferably in the nymph state before migration starts. Retreatment may be necessary at 5 lb rate if infestation is heavy or hoppers migrate.

GRASSHOPPERS, ABMYWORMS & CLIMBING CUTWORMS: Apply at the rate of 5-10 lbs per acre.
