It is a vigilation of rederal law to use this product may only be used to control pocket gophers (Thomomys spp. and Geomys spp.) in subsoil applications (only) in yard and garden areas around homes. This product may only be applied manually, or with the Probe in Funnel Rit, or by use of the Gopher Balt Applicator or Gopher Getter Midget hand probes. Balt must be deposited directly into pocket gophers natural underground runways. Do not apply balt above ground. Do not apply this product by means of a burrow-builder machine. LOCATING RUNWAYS: To locate a gopher's natural runway, probe about 6 " to 8 " from an active mound, beginning on the flat side of the horseshoe-shaped depression. Using an iron bar, a strong stick, the probe from a Probe 'n Funnel kit, a Gopher Bait Applicator bait dispensing probe, or a Gopher Getter Midget bait-dispensing probe or other suitable implement, probe 8 " to 10" below the soll level. Soil resistance on probe will decrease when runway is entered.

FLOSING PROBE HOLES: After each bait placement has been made, cover opening with sod or dirt to close hole and exclude light. Do not permit dirt to slit in and cover bait.
