Dear Mr. Hazen:

The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. You are permitted to sell or distribute products under the previously approved labeling for a period of 18 months from the date of this amendment. After this 18-month period, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

— POCKET GOPHERS —
FOR USE IN SUBSOIL ONLY

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE RESTRICTIONS: This product may only be used to control pocket gophers (*Thomomys* spp. and *Geomys* spp.) in subsoil applications (only) in yard and garden areas around homes. This product may only be applied manually, or with the Probe 'n Funnel kit, or by use of the Gopher Bait Applicator or Gopher Getter Midget hand probes. Bait must be deposited directly into pocket gophers' natural underground runways. Do not apply bait above ground. Do not apply this product by means of a burrow-builder machine. Do not apply this product over food or feed crops. Keep pets and other people out of the area during application.

BAITING DIRECTION

LOCATING RUNWAYS: To locate a gopher's natural runway, probe about 6" to 8" from an active mound, beginning on the flat side of the horseshoe-shaped depression. Using an iron bar, a strong stick, the probe from a Probe 'n Funnel kit, a Gopher Bait Applicator bait dispensing probe, or a Gopher Getter Midget bait-dispensing probe or other suitable implement, probe 8" to 10" below the soil level. Soil resistance on probe will decrease when runway is entered.

GOPHER BAITER APPLICATOR:

Turn hand probe unit upside down to attach or remove bait bottle which screws into the dispenser. The 1-lb. container for Wilco Gopher Getter Type 1 Bait may be screwed directly into the bottle into the dispenser. Otherwise, add the amount of bait needed to the bottle that comes with the Gopher Bait Applicator and screw the bottle into the dispenser. Using probe end, probe around mounds to locate runways (see "LOCATING RUNWAYS;" above). Lift handle to deposit bait in each active runway. Close probe holes as indicated below. Pick up or bury any spilled bait immediately. Make 2 to 7 bait sets per burrow system, depending upon the system's apparent length.

GOPHER GETTER MIDGET: Remove cap from built-in bait reservoir. Add bait. Replace and tighten cap. Using Midget probe, probe around mounds to locate runways (see "Locating Runways;" above). Turn crank two full turns clockwise, followed by two full turns counterclockwise, to deposit bait in the runway. Close probe holes as indicated below. Pick up or bury any spilled bait immediately. Make 2 to 7 bait sets per burrow system, depending upon the system's apparent length.

Hand APPLICATIONS AND PROBE 'N FUNNEL APPLICATIONS: Once the runway is located, enlarge probe hole (if necessary) to accommodate baiting. Drop a teaspoonful of bait through probe opening or through the funnel, if using the Probe 'n Funnel kit, take care not to spill bait on the surface. Pick up any spilled bait immediately. Make 2-7 bait sets per burrow system, depending on the system's apparent length. Close probe holes as indicated below.

CLOSING PROBE HOLES: After each bait placement has been made, cover opening with sod or dirt to close hole and exclude light. Do not permit dirt to sift in and cover bait.

TREATMENT RATE: Depending upon pocket gopher population levels, one pound of bait applied manually will treat one to eight acres.

ENDANGERED SPECIES RESTRICTIONS

NOTICE: The killing of a member of an endangered species during strychnine baiting operations may result in a fine under the Endangered Species Act. Before baiting, the user is advised to contact the Regional U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (Endangered Species Specialist) or the local Fish and Game Office for specific information on endangered species. Strychnine baits should not be used in the geographic ranges of the following species except under programs and procedures approved by the U.S. EPA; San Joaquin kit fox, Morro Bay kangaroo rat, Salt Marsh Harvest mouse, gray wolf, and grizzly bear.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store only in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets, under lock and key in a posted storage area.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Recover any spilled product, securely wrap it in several layers of newspaper, and discard in trash. Do not pour any unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Nonrefillable container,
