- 1. In the "APPLICATION DIRECTIONS FOR MANUAL BAITING:", change the subheading "Hand applications:" to "HAND APPLICATIONS:" so that all paragraph headings in the subsection are parallel with one another.
- 2. Also in the "APPLICATION DIRECTIONS FOR MANUAL BAITING:", delete the underlining under the colon in the subheading "BAIT-DISPENSING PROBE APPLICATION:" (i.e., change ":" to ":").

The label changes prescribed above must be incorporated onto the final printed label for this product. Submit one copy of the final printed label before releasing this product for shipment.

The Confidential Statement of Formula dated "6/18/04" is acceptable and describes the only formulation that may be used for this product.

This product is registered for use only to control pocket gophers of the Genera Geomys and Thomomys. Collectively, these organisms are reported to occur in the following States: Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Georgia, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, Minnesota, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oklahoma, Oregon, South Carolina, South Dakota, Texas, Utah, Washington, Wisconsin, and Wyoming. These are the States where use of this product would be legal (if also registered with the individual States) and, therefore, the only States in which it should be sold.

POCKET GOPHERS

FOR USE IN SUBSOIL ONLY

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE RESTRICTIONS: For use on rangeland, pasture, cropland and nonagricultural areas to control only the following species of pocket gophers: Northern (Thomomys talpoides): Southern (Thomomys umbrinue); Camas (Thomomys bulbivorus); Valley (Thomomys bottae); Mazama (Thomomys Amazama): Plains (Geomys bursarius); Mountain (Thomomys Monticola); Townsends's (Thomomys townsendi).

ait must be applied directly into pocket gophers' underground burrow systems. Do not apply this bait above the ground sufface. Do not apply this bait over food or feed crops. Do not broadcast bait. Do not apply this product by use of a burrow-builder machine. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers, other persons, pets or domestic animals. APPLICATION DIRECTIONS FOR MANUAL BAITING:

LOCATING RUNWAYS: To locate a gopher's natural runway, probe about 6" to 8" from an active mound, beginning on the flat side of the horseshoe-shaped depression. Using an iron bar, a strong stick, a bait-dispensing probe or other suitable implement, probe 8" to 10" below soil level. Resistance on probe will decrease when runway is entered.



Hand applications: Once the runway is located, enlarge probe hole (if necessary) to accommodate baiting. Drop a teaspoonful of bait through probe opening, taking care not to spill bait on the surface. Pick up any spilled bait immediately. Closed probe holes as indicated below. Make 2-7 bait sets per burrow system, depending on the system's apparent length.

BAIT-DISPENSING PROBE APPLICATION: Read manufacturer's instructions for the equipment selected for use. Determine how to calibrate equipment or otherwise ensure that each bait placement will be approximately one teaspoonful. Once the main runway is located through probing, operate the dispenser to release bait into the tunnel. Pick up or bury any spilled bait immediately. Close probe holes as indicated below. Make 2 to 7 bait sets per burrow system, depending upon the system's apparent length.

CLOSING PROBE HOLES: After bait placement has been made, cover opening with sod or dirt to close hole and exclude light. Do not permit dirt to sift in and cover bait.

TREATMENT RATES: Depending upon pocket gopher population levels, one pound of bait applied manually will treat one to eight acres.
