Spot treat floors and baseboards in infested rooms where the pets eat, sleep, and rest. Spot treat under furniture. Do not apply to the cushions of furniture or bedding. FLEAS AND BROWN DOG TICKS OUTDOORS: For treatment of localized infestations of these insects in outdoor areas where there are weeds or bushy non-crop areas, spray infested areas thoroughly. Repeat application as infestations warrant and as reinfestation occurs.

CLOTHES MOTHS AND CARPET BEETLES: Spray edges of carpeting and under carpeting. Rugs and closets. Make localized applications to the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into crack and crevices, closets and infested areas of shelving, and/or wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.
