- Under the "Fist Aid" statement revise as follow: 3.

If Swallowed: "Promptly drink large quantity of water if able to swallow" to read: "Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow".

If in Eyes: "Hold eye open and flush with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes" to read: "Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes".

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. A single CLEARVIEW 1' CHLORINATING TABLET will provide 1.0 pom available chlorine by weight per 3,000 gallons of swimming pool water. Reentry into treated pools is prohibited above levels of 3.0 ppm available chlorine. Outdoor pools stabilized with CLEARVIEW WATER CONDITIONER will require less chlorine. See directions on container label. This product is manufactured for use in erosion-type tablet feeders, whorein the water flows over the tablets slowly, providing a constant chloring feed rate. Do not place tablets directly into the pool. Contact with concrete and viryl may cause staining.

## CHLORINATION:

Establish an initial chlorine residual: Establish an initial chlorine residual in the 10 -3.0 pom range with a fast-dissolving, granular product such as CLEARVIEW GRANULAR CHLORINATING CONCENTRATE or a liquid chlorinating product, Follow directions of the labels of these products.

Maintenance of the chlorine residual: When an initial residual has been established maintain the residual with 14 tablets per 8,000 gallons every 7 - 14 days in a chlorine tablet feeder.
