ISOCYANURATE RED ATTACHEMENT A

LABELING: (Statements are based on review of referenced acute toxicity data)

1. The signal word is "DANGER"
2. Revise the Precautionary Statements to read:

CORROSIVE: Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. May be fatal if absorbed through skin. May be fatal if inhaled. Do not breathe dust or spray mists. Irritating to nose and throat. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield, protective clothing and rubber gloves when handling this product. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

3. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment to read:

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT.

IF SWALLOWED: Drink promptly large quantities of water. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a physician or poison control center immediately.

IF IN EYES: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably, mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use POOLAID ALGAE CURE in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

ELIMINATION OF EXISTING ALGAE GROWTH:

POOLAID ALGAE CURE is highly effective for control of black and green algae infestations and will aid in the removal of algae stains on surfaces in contact with pool or spa water. Treat pool or spa water only when pool or spa is not in use. Repeat treatment whenever visible algae growth occurs. Turn off filter and pump prior to application and keep off for at least 8 hours after treatment.

1. Brush algae spots on walls and bottom with a stainless steel brush.

2. Sprinkle POOLAID ALGAE CURE directly over pool or spa walls and/or bottom where algae growth appears. Use approximately 16 ounces POOLAID ALGAE CURE per 10,000 gallons of pool water. For spas, use 3/4 - 1 ounce per 500 gallons. For heavy algae growth, dosage may be doubled.

3. Brush algae spots again with a stainless steel brush and vacuum debris to waste.

SUPERCHLORINATION

Swimming pools and spas should be superchlorinated once each 7 - 10 days when in use, after rain or dust storms, during hot weather, and whenever water is cloudy or floating algae appear on the water surface.

Broadcast 7 1/2 - 15 ounces POOLAID ALGAE CURE per 10,000 gallons pool water over the deepest end of the pool. For spas, use 3/8 to 3/4 ounces POOLAID ALGAE CURE per 500 gallon spread evenly over water surface of spa.

AFTER TREATMENT:

1. Measure pH of pool or spa water immediately after application. Use a reliable test kit. If necessary adjust and maintain pH within 7.2 - 7.6 range. POOLAID DRY ACID lowers pH. POOLAID SODA ASH raises pH. Follow directions for use on these products.

2. Reentry into treated swimming pools or spas is prohibited above levels of 3.0 ppm available chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep product dry in a tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container, if possible, and flood with large quantities of water to dissolve all material before discarding. Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap

original container with several layers of newspaper and place in trash.

FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED: Feed bread soaked in water or olive oil. Call a physician immediately.

IF ON SKIN: Brush off excess chemical. Wash with water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with cold water for at least 15 minutes. Remove contact lenses. Continue flushing with water. Get medical attention.
