DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Elimination of Existing Algae Growth: CLEARVIEWTM "ALGAECURE" is highly effective for control of black and green algae infestations and will aid in the removal of algae only when pool or spa is not in use. Repeat treatment whenever visible algae growth occurs. Turn off filter and pump prior to application and keep off for at least 8 hours after treatment.


- 1. Brush algae spots on walls and bottom with a stainless steel brush.
- 2. Sprinkle CLEARVIEWTM "ALGAECURE" directly over pool or spa walls and/or bottom where algae growth appears. Use approximately 16 ounces CLEARVIEWTM "ALGAECURE" per 10,000 gallons of pool water. For spas, use 3/4 1 ounce per 500 gallons. For heavy algae growth, dosage may be doubled.
- 3. Brush algae spots again with a stainless steel brush and vacuum debris to waste.

 Super-chlorination: Swimming pools and spas should be super chlorinated once each 7 10 days when not in use, after rain or dust storms, during hot weather, and whenever water is cloudy or floating algae appears on the water surface.

Broadcast 7 1/2 to 15 ounces CLEARVIEWTM "ALGAECURE" per 10,000 gallons pool water over the deepest end of the pool. For spas, use 3/8 to 3/4 ounces CLEARVIEWTM "ALGAECURE" per 500 gallons spread evenly over water surface of spa.

After Treatment:

- 1. Measure pH of swimming pool or spa water immediately after application. Use a reliable test kit. If necessary, adjust and maintain pH within 7.2 7.6 range. pH Down (dry acid) lowers pH. pH Up (soda ash) raises pH. Follow directions for use contained on the labeling of these products.
- 2. Reentry into treated swimming pools or spas is prohibited above levels of 3.0 ppm available chlorine.



PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARD: Strong Oxidizing Agent. Mix only with water. Use clean, dry utensils. Do not add this product to any dispensing device which contains remnants of other product. Such use may lead to a violent chemical reaction leading to fire and/or explosion. Contamination with moisture, organic matter, or other chemicals may start a chemical reaction with generation of heat, generation of hazardous gases, and/or possible fire and/or explosion. In case of decomposition, isolate container in open air or in a well-ventilated area. If necessary, flood with large quantities of water and flush to a sanitary sewer.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Keep product dry in a tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container, if possible, and flood with large quantities of water to dissolve all material before discarding. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal site. Completely empty plastic liner by shaking or tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill the container. Offer for recycling if available or dispose of plastic liner and container in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by State and local authorities. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
