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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Reentry into treated pools is prohibited above levels of 3.0 ppm [available][of] chlorine.

[A single full strength low odor chlorine CLEARVIEW JUMBO CHLORINATING TABLET (Slow Dissolving, Stabilized Tablets) will provide 4.7 ppm available chlorine by weight per 10,000 gallons of swimming pool water.

CLEARVIEW JUMBO CHLORINATING TABLETS (Slow Dissolving, Stabilized Tablets) [This product] are [is] manufactured for use in erosion-type tablet feeders, wherein the water flows over the tablets slowly, providing a constant chlorine feed rate. Do not place tablets directly into the pool. Contact with concrete and vinyl may cause staining.

CHLORINATION

Establish and Initial Chlorine Residual

Establish an initial chlorine residual in the 1.0 - 3.0 ppm range with a fast-dissolving, granular product such as CLEARVIEW GRANULAR CHLORINATING CONCENTRATE 56 or a liquid chlorinating product. Follow directions on the labels of these products.

Maintenance of Chlorine Residual

When an initial residual has been established, maintain the residual with 1 tablet per 8,000 gallons every 7 -14 days in a chlorine tablet feeder. The number of tablets used ever 7 -14 days may vary with temperature, wind, pool usage, and feeding method. Test the chlorine residual in the pool water frequently with a reliable test kit. Adjust the tablet feed rate as necessary to maintain the chlorine residual in the 1.0 -1.5 ppm range.

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Measure pH of swimming pool water immediately prior to treatment with CLEARVIEW JUMBO CHLORINATING TABLETS [this product]. - 2. Stabilize pool water to at least 40 ppm with Conditioner as directed on the container label. Thereafter, regular use of these POOL STICKS [this product] for daily chlorination will provide any needed makeup conditioner.
- 3. Shock Treat the pool water to oxidize organic contaminants. Follow the label directions. Before using the pool, be certain the chlorine level returns to 1.0 1.5 ppm.
- 4. Maintain a free available chlorine level of 1.0 1.5 ppm (as determined daily by a suitable test kit) at all times. STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep [*this*] product dry in a tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container, if possible, and flood with large quantities of water to dissolve all material before discarding. Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap original container with several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
