DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. A single full strength, low odor, slow dissolving, stabilized jumbo chlorinating tablet will provide 4.7 ppm available chlorine by weight per 10,000 gallons of swimming pool water. Reentry into treated pools is prohibited above levels of 4.0 ppm available chlorine. This product is manufactured for use in erosion-type tablet feeders, wherein the water flows over the tablets slowly, providing a constant chlorine feed rate. Do not place tablets directly into the pool. Contact with concrete and vinyl may cause staining.

CHLORINATION:

Establish an initial chlorine residual: Establish an initial chlorine residual in the 1.0 - 3.0 ppm range with a fast-dissolving, granular product or a liquid chlorinating product. Follow directions on the labels of these products.

Maintenance of chlorine residual: When an initial residual has been established, maintain the residual with 1 tablet per 8,000 gallons every 7 - 14 days in a chlorine tablet feeder. The number of tablets used every 7 - 14 days may vary with temperature, wind, pool usage, and feeding method. Test the chlorine residual in the pool water frequently with a reliable test kit. Adjust the tablet feed rate as necessary to maintain the chlorine residual in the 1.0 - 1.5 ppm range.

pH: Measure pH of swimming pool water immediately prior to treatment with this product. Use a reliable test kit. If necessary, adjust and maintain pH within 7.2 - 7.6 range. pH DOWN lowers pH. pH UP raises pH. Follow directions for use on these products.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: CORROSIVE: Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. May be fatal if absorbed through skin. May be fatal if inhaled. Do not breathe dust or spray mists. Irritating to nose and throat. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield, protective clothing and rubber gloves when handling this product. 
